## Dress Code Early Years to Grade 6

**Hillcrest Montessori Elementary School** students are required to dress and groom themselves in a way that aligns with our philosophy of maintaining a learning environment focused on the development of each student's academic potential, personal character and leadership skills.

All **Hillcrest Montessori Elementary School** students are expected to be in school uniform during school hours and during all school activities and events unless otherwise specified. Attire which attracts undue or negative attention or which infringes on the rights or values of others is not considered to be in the spirit of the dress.

**The Hillcrest Montessori Elementary School school crest will be visible at all times.**

Students are allowed to wear their Formal-Dress Uniform on any day of the week, if preferred. However, elements from Full Dress and Everyday Uniforms cannot be interchanged and Everyday Uniforms cannot be worn on Full Dress Days. Every Friday is Full Dress Uniform Day. At the Principal's discretion, other Full Dress Uniform Days may be announced.

By signing the registration documents, students, staff, parents, and volunteers agree to abide by the dress code policy. In doing so, we are choosing to be actively engaged in the safe and secure, nurturing environment of this exceptional learning community.

Any medical or religious concerns or limitations that might preclude meeting the uniform guidelines should be addressed with the School Principal to determine if reasonable accommodations are necessary.

It is recommended that students' clothing be labeled; everything will look alike in the lost and found. The school will not be held personally liable for any lost personal items.

Ensure you choose clothing for class wear as well as gym days i.e., sweatpants and preferably a non hooded sweater as children at this age tend to pull each other on by grabbing the hoodie which can cause a safety concern.

## Hillcrest Montessori Elementary School Crest Regulations

The Hillcrest Montessori Elementary School crest is a symbol of our community, values, and commitment to excellence in education. These regulations ensure consistent and respectful use of the crest on uniforms, promotional materials, and official documents. ***Parents can purchase official crests at the school office for the 2025–2026 school year.***

### 1. Placement:

The crest must be placed on the left side of all uniforms in a clearly visible location. On jackets, sweatshirts, and other outerwear, the crest must remain unobstructed and visible when worn.

### 2. Size & Proportions:

The crest must maintain its original proportions; it may not be stretched, compressed, or altered. It must fit naturally on the uniform without overlapping seams or design elements.

### 3. Color & Design:

No alterations to color, design, or elements of the crest are permitted without approval from the School Principal.

### 4. Materials & Application:

For uniforms, the crest should be properly sewn on or embroidered.

### 5. Usage Restrictions:

The crest may not be used in any manner that could misrepresent the school, its values, or its community.

Unauthorized use on personal clothing, merchandise, or online materials is prohibited.

### 6. Compliance:

All students, staff, and volunteers are expected to follow these regulations.

Any exceptions for religious, medical, or safety reasons must be approved by the School Principal.

### 7. Maintenance:

Families are responsible for maintaining the crest on uniforms, ensuring it is intact, clean, and visible at all times.



## UNIFORM POLICIES SPECIFIC TO BOTH BOYS & GIRLS

### Early Years to Grade 6

**Shoe:** Flat, closed toe, non-marking sole. Black or Navy-Blue shoes or moccasins (Do not buy laced shoe if your child has not learned how to tie laces as laces are tripping hazard. White soles are acceptable

**Shirts** Buttoned to one below top. Must have a collar and be tucked in at all times.

**Vests, Sweaters, Cardigans** Approved uniform shirt must be worn underneath at all times. Sleeves must not extend past the wrists and cover the hands. Jackets, and other outerwear may not be worn indoors.

**Socks and Hosiery** Socks must be black or navy blue. Socks must always be worn and be visible and cover the ankle (i.e., ankle and “no show” socks are not permitted). Crew, dress, trouser, and knee socks are acceptable.

**Undergarments** Undergarments or straps must not be visible and must therefore be skin-toned or of similar/lighter color to the uniform. With white dress shirts, undergarments must be solid white; no other colors, prints or designs are permitted. Long sleeve undergarments under short sleeve shirts are also not permitted.

**Hair** Hair must be clean, neat, and out of the eyes. Only natural colors are allowed. Hair styling or coloring arrangements which are disruptive or distracting are not permissible.

**Jewelry** No jewelry should not be worn as it creates a safety hazard. Body/facial piercings and gauges are not permitted. Small studs on ears are acceptable.

Necklaces and bracelets are not to be worn. Eyeglasses may not be overly ornate, and may not be shaded indoors or otherwise restrictive to the vision. Watches are not permitted as they are more of a toy than telling time.

**Sun Protection** Items such as hats and sunglasses may be worn only when outdoors.

**Outerwear** All outerwear and bags are to be plain in color and design. No blatant advertising, no large corporate logos, sports teams, television or other organization or media logos or designs are permitted. Outerwear is not to be worn inside the building and should be removed as soon as is practical when entering the school.

**Other** No visible tattoos are permitted. Any tattoos acquired before admission to HMA will be dealt with on an individual basis by the principal. No hats, no scarves and no bandanas indoors. Colognes, perfumes, and pungent substances which may cause distraction or allergic reactions are not permitted.



## UNIFORM POLICIES SPECIFIC TO BOTH BOYS & GIRLS

### Early Years to Grade 6

As a general guideline, skirts, skorts, and jumpers are to be worn no higher than halfway between the top of the kneecap and the tips of the fingers when standing up straight with Skirts, Skorts, and the arm hanging straight down. Jumpers They must be a modest length and the waistband must not be rolled over. The top of skirts and skorts must be worn within one inch of the natural waist.

**Jumper** Must be worn with navy blue shorts, tights or leggings underneath.

**Socks and Hosiery** Navy blue tights or leggings can be worn under skirts, skorts, or jumpers if desired. Girls are required to wear navy blue knee socks or tights with Tunics.

Undergarments Camisoles following undergarment color requirements are acceptable.

Shorts (other than gym uniform) should not be visible under hemline with no visible logo and must be navy blue or black in color.

**Hair** accessories should be minimal, appropriate for an academic environment and not distracting. Headbands in one solid color (navy blue, black, white or pale blue matching our school colors) are permissible.

**Jewelry** Female students are allowed to wear one pair of small earrings, with no more than one earring in each ear and no larger than ½” in diameter. Dangling or hoop earrings are safety hazards and are not permitted. Gauges are not permitted.

**Cosmetics** Girls in Early Years are prohibited from wearing any coloured nail polish, make-up or hair dye.
